

Supplementary information regarding Roblee genealogy (June, 1949)

Data supplied by Mrs. William W. Roblee of Riverside, California, gives the following additional information regarding the early generations of the family:

Zero Generation: The father of Ruben¹ Roblee was named Thomas. This is indicated by the fact that Jerusha Roblee (daughter of Ruben²) is entered as "Great grand-daughter of Thomas Rubbelee" in the records of the Hicks family of Granville, N.Y.

It is possible that this Thomas Rubbelee lived in the "Great Nine Partners" tract in Dutchess County, N.Y., and that he was the progenitor of both the Granville and the Nova Scotia branches of the family.

Second generation.

Ruben² Rubbelee married Mary. (Family name of Mary still unknown.) The Hicks records indicate that Jerusha was daughter of Ruben and Mary Rubbelee. This confirms the fact, already deduced from other information, that there were two Rubens, father and son. The first Ruben married Phebe _____; the second Mary _____.

The will mentions the above seven children by name and makes it quite clear that there were no other living children except the unnamed daughter by his first wife, from whom he separated. The real estate was willed to the three sons, Luther, Calvin and Theron; and a quit-claim deed on file at Hudson Falls, N.Y. transferred to Luther the undivided two-thirds interest of Calvin and Theron and their wives. All the children named attended the probate proceedings and their married names are given in the record.
Luther, Calvin and Theron are buried at North Creek. Dates taken from their tombstones.

Sources: The existence and composition of this family is inferred from several circumstances: Hamilton Robblee (son of Thomas and Laura) informed his granddaughter Helen Robblee (Towne) that his father and mother were cousins. This is also shown by the Will of Thomas Robblee, probated in 1831, in which his daughter Laura's name is given as Laura Robblee. She was married at the time and all the daughters' married names were used. Thomas³ was therefore son of a brother of Thomas². Marion Robblee Bernard, granddaughter of II Norman, states that Norman was brought up by his brother Thomas (and sister-in-law Laura) after their parents' death; also that Norman's father's name was Ruben, and that the children named above were Norman's brothers and sisters. Norman could not be a son of Ruben and Phebe (first generation) as Ruben¹ died in 1795 and Norman was not born until 1815.

Herman Roblee was born in the town of Granville, and brought up by his brother Thomas³ after his parents' death. He lived at Kendall, Orleans Co., N.Y., 1835-50; North Creek 1850-68, Wilton, N.Y. 1868-71, Fairbault, Minn. 1871-75, and Canisteo, N.Y. 1875-1900. When construction of the Adirondack Railroad was suspended in the winter of 1850-51 he contracted with the unemployed stone masons to build the stone house which is still standing on Route 9, one mile south of North Creek.

Dear Mrs. Roblee,

At the suggestion of Mrs. Joseph H. Roblee of St. Louis I am sending you herewith a set of genealogical data on the Roblee family according to the latest information I have been able to secure up to now. This incorporates all the material in the previous compilation, which I believe was largely your work, of which I had a copy on loan from Mrs. Barnard of Granville.

Like Mrs. Barnard I am one of the descendants of II Norman, who was brother to Thomas and cousin to Thomas' wife Laura. Marion -- Mrs. Barnard -- has supplied several of the clues needed to work out the true relationship of the various members of the earlier generations, but the most important information came from the wills and deeds recorded at Salem and Hudson Falls. I hope it may still be possible to visit the locality of the Roblee farms west of Granville and south of Middle Granville, and to locate the tomb-stones of the various Rubens, Thomases and Samuel so as to confirm the information we have. It may be there is a family burying ground, as was so often the case in the early days.

As I am a missionary in Belgian Congo, and only at home on furlough once in four years, it is not easy to get such researches in. We expect to return at the end of June, so whatever I do must be done soon. I am accordingly sending this much on to you now, as I am fully engaged for the next ten days at least and so may not have another chance to do much with these investigations.

I have rearranged the material by generations, as that arrangement is generally easier to use when more material is found and added from time to time. I also started to subdivide the later generations by branches so as to make it easier to find a given group of families; but this is really not very necessary yet. However if anyone were to complete the material on the descendants of Luther, Calvin and Theron down to date it would become quite voluminous, and this subdivision would help. I have sent a copy of this material to Mr. R. Ellsworth Roblee of North Creek, and hope that he will help you secure this fuller information. I shall try also to complete the information on the descendants of Norman (and especially of my grandmother, Cynthia Amelia Roblee (Carr)). Most of this can be had from the Carr Book; but I am ashamed that I do not know more of it without depending on books for it.

I am also sending a copy of the picture of the house Great Grandfather Norman Roblee built at North Creek in 1851. It is now occupied by a Mr. Harris, grandson of Abigail Roblee (Monthony). Their names should also be in the list, but I do not know just where.
